Waterloo Uncovered (WU) is a registered charity. It was established in 2015 (the Battle of Waterloo's bicentenary year) to conduct the first ever major archaeological excavation of the Waterloo Battlefield, Belgium, and support the military community.

The Waterloo Uncovered volunteer programme is in its early days, and looks to provide opportunities for volunteers to take part in the project.

Areas we are seeking support for include (but are not limited to): post excavation, administrative support, communications, education and outreach, fundraising, veteran support, welfare and wellbeing, and on the summer excavation.
